

COVID-19 Response: Roadmap for Reopening

Guiding Decision Factors

Decisions regarding the reopening of our day services will be based on four guiding factors.

Guidelines From State And Local Authorities, Including Gov. Holcomb

Recommendations From The Centers For Disease Control And Prevention The Needs, Risk Factors And Abilities Of The People We Serve And Our Staff

Resources Available For PPE, Staffing, Training, And Social Distancing

Timeline

With these guiding factors in mind, staff members will report to their assigned locations beginning May 18 to undergo on-site training in preparation for a resumption of services. The target date to begin a phased-in reopening of Noble's services is June 1. Please note that these dates are subject to change based on the guiding factors above.

General Operating Policies

- ✓ No visitors will be allowed at this time.
- ✓ Upon arrival each day, all staff and participants will be screened for symptoms, including temperature checks.
- ✓ Any staff or participants with symptoms will be sent home and instructed to contact their health care provider.
- Any staff or participants who becomes symptomatic during operating hours will remain in a designated isolation area until they can go home.
- ✓ All guidelines for appropriate PPE for staff and participants will be followed, including face masks for all.

Day Service Operating Policies

- Our service hours will be modified to accommodate the needs of those we serve and to alleviate congestion/preserve social distancing at drop-off and pick-up times.
- ✓ Noble may recommend that high-risk individuals continue to shelter in place rather than participate in services. High-risk participants include those who are 65 or older or have chronic medical conditions. Each individual will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- ✓ Groups will be limited to four participants and one staff per work area/team room to ensure a minimum of 6-foot spacing for social distancing. Tables & chairs will be spaced.
- ✓ All team rooms/common areas will be disinfected before and after operating hours.
- ✓ High-touch areas will be disinfected every 2 hours and as needed throughout the day.
