## **Providing A Safe Camp Experience**

Despite COVID-19, we are working hard to ensure the health & safety of our campers while providing a fun camp experience for the kids & a much-needed break for parents. Here are some of the precautions we are implementing as we proceed with a shortened version of our 2020 Summer Day Camps:

### **CAMPERS**

- ✓ Provide a 2:1 camper to counselor ratio.
- ✓ Campers will have their temperature taken & overall health assessed upon arrival each day.
- ✓ We will assign tables for individual activities & lunch.
- ✓ We will encourage 6-foot social distancing during group activities.
- ✓ Campers will be encouraged to wear a face mask.
- ✓ Scheduled handwashing every 2 hours (*with monitoring to ensure 20-second timeframe*).

### **CAMP COUNSELORS**

- ✓ Camp & admin staff will have their temperature taken & overall health assessed daily.
- ✓ Camp & admin staff **MUST** wear face masks.
- ✓ High-touch surfaces will be cleaned frequently, as well as before & after each use.
- ✓ Maintain 6-foot social distancing when possible.

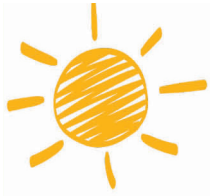
**\*PLEASE NOTE:** Any camper or staff member who is confirmed to have COVID-19 will cause the camp to be placed on hold.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Able to focus 15 minutes at a time and enjoys group activities.

Music is the rhythm of life so we will rock it out with instruments, special guests and a variety of music genres. Of course, we will be moving to the music by learning a few dance steps as well. *For ages 13 - 18.*

**ELIGIBILITY:** Interested in music, dancing, singing & playing instruments, can focus 10-15 minutes at a time, ok with loud musical instruments, & enjoys group activities with lots of movement.
