That partnership offers a win for everyone involved. Noble elevates its therapeutic art service with Art Therapy interns from the University of Indianapolis. UIndy secures valuable, real-world experience for its students. For their part, artists with disabilities served by Noble enhance their creative techniques while tapping into the universal language of art.

“This community partnership is so powerful because it truly fills a need for both organizations,” said **Dr. Sarah Wareham**, associate professor in the School of Education, former special education teacher and current Noble Board Member. “UIndy students get an immersive experience working alongside adults with disabilities and Noble gains a steady connection to highly trained and capable students who can support and expand the creative work that is already happening.”

Hanging with Friends at Summer Camp



Ryan and **Gabe** tease each other with the familiarity of a lifelong friendship. They had met each other at **Summer Day Camp** years ago and hit it off, quickly becoming best friends. From the paint-splattered table they shared in the Noble East Art Studio during one morning of this year's Art Camp, they worked together on a couple pieces before teaming up with fellow campers on others.

For over 20 years, Noble has hosted a series of one-week summer day camps for school-age youth with and without disabilities. Each camp week carries a

theme, like Music & Dance or Get Your Game On, and they feature a 4:1 camper to counselor ratio for more individualized support. Our first week of camp this year was our Fun & Games Camp for ages 8-12 years old, with activities ranging from bowling and putt-putt golf to basketball and splash pads.

During Art Camp, campers unleashed their creativity on a variety of projects, like the coasters that Gabe and Ryan were working on in the Art Studio. Using sharpie markers to draw a pattern on the blank coaster and dripping rubbing alcohol to create impressive drip patterns, they turned each plain white surface into a unique tapestry of color. Once the finished coasters received a protective layer, they were ready to be given to the campers' parents as gifts.
