# PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, in Indiana, more than 32,000 women and men work as Direct Support Professionals, providing exemplary and critical support and services to thousands of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, these professionals provide essential, individualized services that empower individuals with disabilities to live meaningful and fulfilling lives by assisting with daily activities such as personal care, transportation, navigating employment opportunities, and attending medical appointments; and
- WHEREAS, Direct Support Professionals must build close, respectful and trusted relationships with the people they support, requiring compassion, empathy and the highest ethical standards; and
- WHEREAS, the majority of direct support professionals are employed in home and community-based settings, efforts must be made to grow the direct support professionals workforce, increase retention, and reduce turnover; and
- WHEREAS, every day, Indiana's Direct Support Professionals make a tremendous difference in the lives of people with disabilities, strengthening our communities and supporting Hoosiers with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Braun, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 13-19th, 2026, as

Direct Support Professionals Week  
in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
